## Lesson #6

Shavuot: The Festival of Weeks

Leviticus 23:15-22

\_\_\_\_\_ is always, always, always 50 days after the Festival of \_\_\_\_\_

Leviticus 23:15 *From the day after the Sabbath, the day you brought the sheaf of the wave offering, count off seven full weeks.*

Leviticus 23:16 *Count off 50 days up to the day after the seventh Sabbath, then present an offering of new grain unto the LORD.*

The 50<sup>th</sup> day, or the day of Shavuot/Pentecost is always, always, always on the first day of the week. The first day of the week is commonly referred to as “Sunday.”

Exodus 19:1-2 On the first day of the third month the Israelites reached the base of Mt. Sinai.

Exodus 19:3 Moses went up Mt. Sinai. Exodus 19:7 Moses came down Mt. Sinai.

Exodus 19:8 Moses went up Mt. Sinai. Exodus 19:10-11 *And the LORD said to Moses, “Go to the people and consecrate them today and tomorrow. Have them wash their clothes and be ready by the third day, because on that day the LORD will come down on Mt. Sinai in the sight of all people.”* Exodus 19:14 Moses came down Mt. Sinai.

Exodus 19:16-19 On the morning of the third day, **God shows up.**

Exodus 19:20 Moses went up Mt. Sinai. Exodus 19:24 Moses came down Mt. Sinai.
